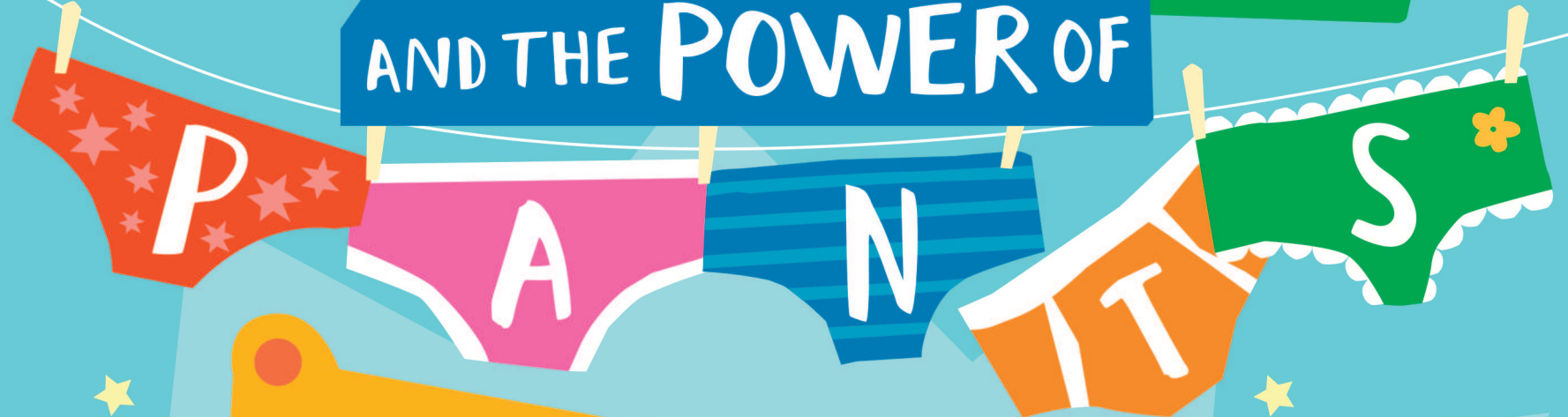

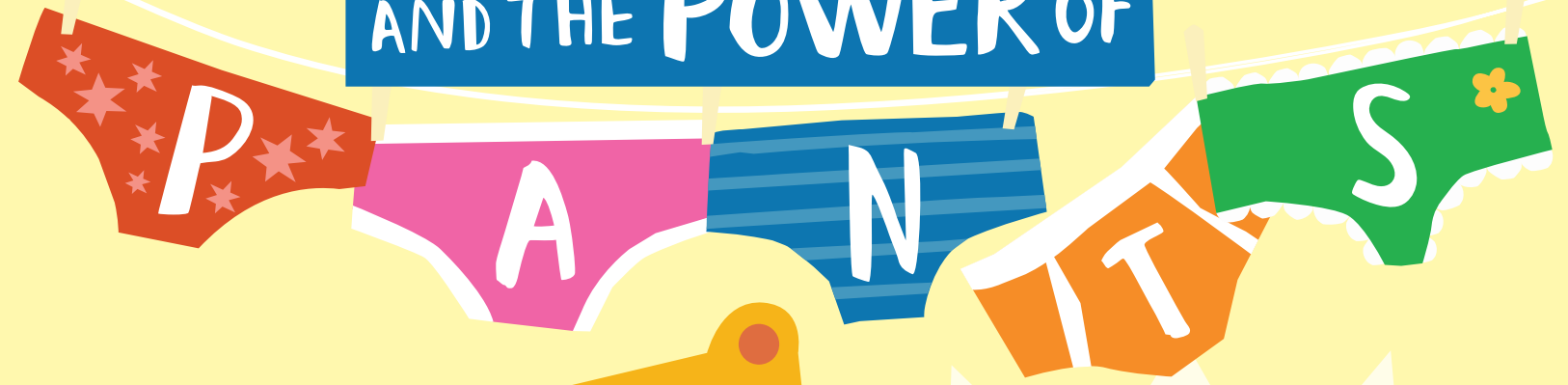

Dinodad and Pantosaurus dance all the way ...

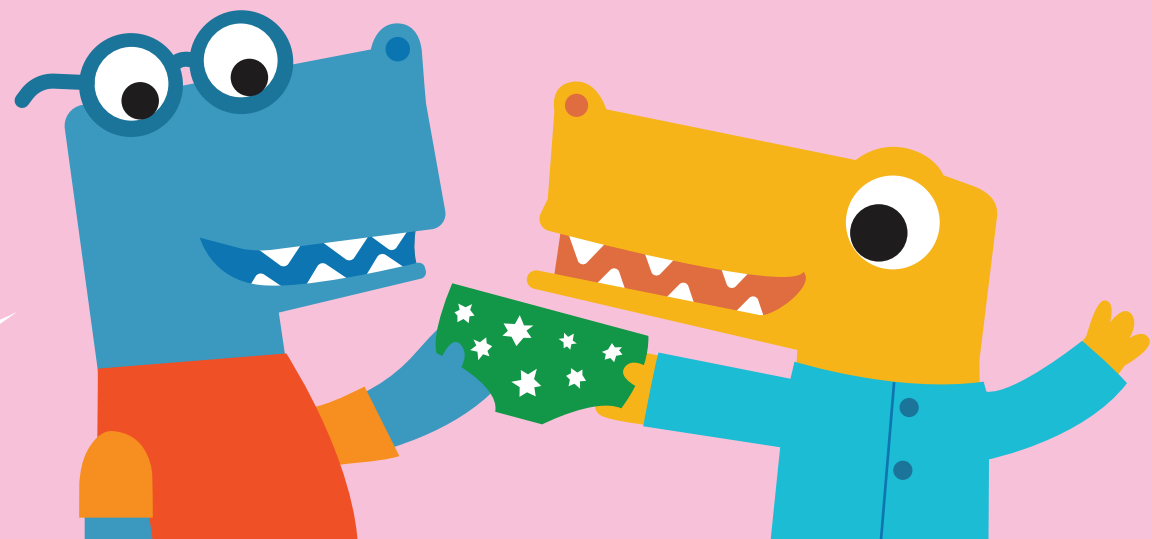
PANTS,

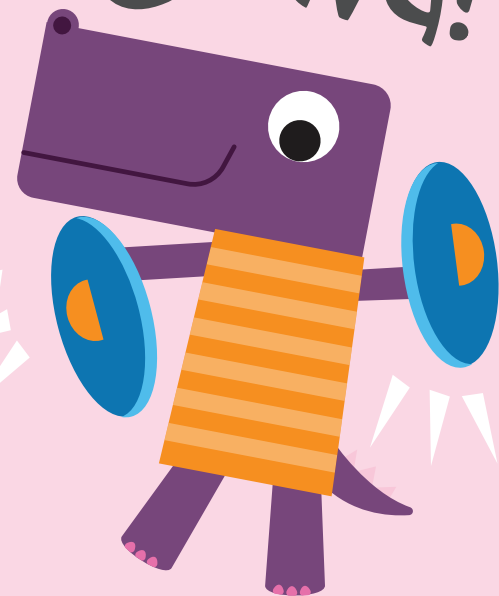
